

Guidance in the event of an accident

- Ensure you, your passengers and your vehicle are out of danger. Your safety should be the priority.
- If required, the emergency services should be notified.
- Do not make any admissions or concessions without speaking to your insurer first.
- You should try to record as much information about the accident as possible, including but not limited to:
 - Registrations and, where possible, the make, model and colour of any other vehicles involved.
 - Names and contact information of any other drivers, injured persons or witnesses.
 - Pictures of the damage caused to all vehicles involved.
 - Pictures of the road layout and vehicle positions where relevant.

Please call 03333058120 to report the claim to our notification team.

Ensuring we are notified as early as possible is vital.

They will set up a new claim and make arrangements to recover your vehicle if required.
